You should do this **after August 1, 2010**, as the visa is only valid for 3 months. You will need a passport photo and a copy of the full itinerary (available when hotels and flights are confirmed). The visa office only accepts cash payments.

A **Tour Book** will be distributed to everyone attending the tour about one month prior to departure date. This will include hotel contact information and all flight details.

Important Note:

During these exciting two weeks of sightseeing in China we will be staying in 6 different hotels (7 if you take up the Hong Kong option).

As we will be moving around a lot, taking buses, checking into hotels, checking in at airports, it is **IMPORTANT** to keep your luggage to a minimum. Do not bring unnecessary items, pack toiletries into small containers, and try to keep your souvenir shopping for the end of the trip especially if you intend to purchase large items.

It can be very cumbersome if you have to drag too much luggage around on a trip like this, not to mention the excess luggage fee that you will be charged at airports.

Keep your total check-in luggage weight to under 20kgs, taking into account items you may purchase on the trip.

Spending Money: You should bring a minimum of AUD\$500 spending money or a credit card to cover tips, purchase of water and other incidentals.

Weather in China during October:

Beijing (in the north) – average daytime temperature is 19 degrees C (66 F)
It will be cool during the day and chilly at night.

Hangzhou (central) – average daytime temperature is 23 degrees C (73 F)
It will be warm during the day and cooler at night

Guangzhou (in the south) – average daytime temperature is 29 degrees C (83 F)
It will quite warm.

Overall, the weather is great for sightseeing – mild and comfortable.

COST (subject to change):

From Melbourne return (without HK option)

US\$3,700

(includes all flights, meals and accommodation)

From Melbourne return (with HK option)

US\$4,000

(includes all flights and accommodation. Includes all meals, except in Hong Kong where you will need to pay for your own meals)

From Beijing -> Fuzhou (excluding international flights)

US\$2,500

(includes all flights, meals and accommodation)

From Beijing -> Fuzhou -> Hong Kong (excluding international flights)

US\$2,800

(includes all flights and accommodation. Includes all meals, except in Hong Kong where you will need to pay for your own meals)

Note that all hotel rooms are shared between 2 people. If you require a single room throughout the trip, add US\$550 for China tour without Hong Kong option, or US\$700 for China tour with Hong Kong option.

CANCELLATION POLICY

All tour participants are strongly urged to obtain travel insurance.

In order to give you the best possible rate for this tour, we book your flights and hotels as soon as you make your booking. Therefore, in the event of cancellation, we are obliged to charge the following:

Administration fees for cancellation:

1. If cancellation is received before September 1, 2010, cancellation fee is 15% of total tour cost.
2. If cancellation is received September 1, 2010 or later, full trip cost is forfeited (NO REFUND). This is why it is essential you get trip insurance in case of personal emergency or sudden illness.
4. NO REFUNDS for voluntary termination of travel AFTER trip begins. If a member must involuntarily cancel for physical health reasons AFTER the trip has begun and does not use a portion of their already pre-paid services, NO refunds will be made. No refunds are made for unused excursions and special program activities.
